RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5707, S-2013

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT GUTTED SIX (6) RESIDENTIAL HOUSES COMPRISING OF TEN (10) FAMILIES IN AREA 5, BARANGAY SAUYO, THIS CITY, LAST MARCH 3, 2013 IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER TO BE TAKEN FROM GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND DONATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to provide, as it does hereby provide financial assistance to the victims of fire that gutted six (6) residential houses comprising of ten (10) families in Area 5, Barangay Sauro, last March 3, 2013 in the amount of two thousand pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer to be taken from Grants, Subsidies and Donations of the Office of the City Mayor, or from any available funds of the City Treasury.
