WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is committed to uphold children's rights and protection and pursue programs and mechanisms to ensure the protection and development of children as mandated by the Constitution;

WHEREAS, the Millennium Development Goals (MDG's) are a set of time-bound, concrete and specific goals to reduce extreme poverty, illiteracy and disease by 2015; where 6 out of 8 goals indicated directly affect children;

WHEREAS, as part of the city's commitment to fulfill the MDG's, realize the provisions of the Convention on the Rights of Children and create a Child-Friendly City, the Local Development Plan and Mid-Term Investment Plan shall be the guiding instrument for all projects and programs of the city directed for the protection and development of children;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council for the Protection of Children (QCCPC), pursuant to Section 58 of the Quezon City Children's Code (SP-2180 S-2012), has formulated the city's Local Government Plan and Midterm Investment Plan specifically for Children to operationalize the provisions of the said code;

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2012 the QCCPC approved the Quezon City Local Development Plan for Children and the Medium Term Investment Plan for Children under Resolution No. 02-2012;

WHEREAS, together, the plans which covers the Medium Term (2014-2016) is focused on the four (4) categories of Child's Rights which include Survival, Development, Protection and Participation based on the core principles of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child;


WHEREAS, both Plans are guided by the mission, goals and objectives of the Philippine National Strategic Framework for Plan Development for Children or "Child 21", the Millennium Development Goals and the Comprehensive Development Plan of the city;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the Quezon City Council to adopt the City's Local Development Plan for Children and Medium Term Investment Plan for Children in order to ensure the effective implementation of the proposed plans and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to adopt, as it does hereby adopt the Quezon City Development Plan for Children and the Quezon City Medium Term Investment Plan for Children for the years 2013 to 2016.
