RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5733, S-2013

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE QUEZON CITY LOCAL POVERTY REDUCTION ACTION PLAN (QC-LPRAP) LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS IN QUEZON CITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED TEN MILLION TWO HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE PESOS (P110,228,125.00) IN ACCORDANCE WITH PRESIDENTIAL EXECUTIVE ORDER NO 43, S-11 DATED 13 MAY 2011 AND DEPARTMENTS OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT, SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT, INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND THE NATIONAL ANTI-POVERTY COMMISSION JOINT MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO 3, SERIES OF 2013.

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 43, S-11 (13 May 2011) issued by His Excellency, President Benigno Simeon C. Aquino, III mandated the Cabinet to be organized as clusters to serve as a primary mechanism of the Executive Branch towards the realization of the Social Contract with the Filipino People;

WHEREAS, the Human Development and Poverty Reduction Cluster (HDPRC) was tasked to focus on improving the overall quality of the life of the Filipino people and translating the gains of good governance into direct, immediate and substantial benefits that will empower the poor and marginalized segments of society;

WHEREAS, the Departments of Budget and Management, Interior and Local Government, Social Welfare and Development, and the National Anti Poverty Commission issued Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2012, providing policy guidelines and procedures in the bottom-up approach in planning and budgeting to be able to ensure the inclusion of the funding requirements for the development needs of at least 300 of the 609 focus Local Government Units as identified and approved by the Human Development and Poverty Reduction Cluster (HDPRC);

WHEREAS, by virtue of DBM-DILG-DSWD-NAPC Joint Memorandum Circular No. 3, Series of 2013, the Quezon City Government converted the Anti Poverty Integration Task Force into the Quezon City Local Poverty Reduction Action Team (QC-LPRAT), through Executive Order No. 5, Series of 2012, as amended by Executive Order No. 5-A Series of 2013 (21 February 2013) issued by the Honorable Mayor Herbert M. Bautista, implementing the Bottom Up Planning and Budgeting for the Fiscal Year 2014 Budget Preparation;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Local Poverty Reduction Action Team through the Bottom Up Planning and Budgeting preparation and has endorsed the same for submission to the National Anti-Poverty Commission and Department of the Interior and Local Government.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to approve, as it does hereby approve, the Quezon City Local Poverty Reduction Action Plan (QC-LPRAP) list of priority projects in Quezon City for Calendar Year 2014 in the amount of One Hundred Ten Million Two Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty Five Pesos (P110,228,125.00) in accordance with Presidential Executive Order No. 43, S-11 dated 13 May 2011 and Departments of Budget and Management, Social Welfare and Development, Interior and Local Government and the National Anti-Poverty Commission Joint Memorandum Circular No. 3, Series of 2013.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Seventy Percent (70%) of the total cost amounting to Seventy Two Million Eight Hundred Eight Thousand Eighty Seven Pesos and Twenty Centavos (P72,808,087.20) is proposed to be funded by the National Government Agencies and the remaining Thirty Percent (30%) amounting to Thirty Seven Million Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Seven Pesos and Eighty Centavos (P37,420,937.80.00) will be the City Government's counterpart;

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that the Quezon City Local Poverty Reduction Action Plan (QC-LPRAP) list of priority projects for 2014 shall be made an integral part of this Resolution.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that a copy of this Resolution along with its attachment be submitted to the Department of Budget and Management, Department of Social Welfare and Development, Department of the Interior and Local Government, National Anti-Poverty Commission, Secretariat of the Human Development and Poverty Reduction Cluster, Office of the President and other national government agencies for integration in their respective budgets for Fiscal Year 2014.


