A RESOLUTION URGING ALL PRIVATE AND STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES IN QUEZON CITY TO REQUIRE THEIR GRADUATE SCHOOL STUDENTS TO PROVIDE THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC LIBRARY WITH COPIES OF THEIR RESEARCHES, THESIS OR DISSERTATION PARTICULARLY THOSE WITH QUEZON CITY AS SUBJECT MATTER.

It offers both fiction and non-fiction books, in addition to encyclopedias and other basic reference materials, for both children and adults. It now also offers free use of computers as well as free internet access;

WHEREAS, to students of means, the lack of public libraries is not a problem as to others. They can afford to buy books, newspapers and other reading materials of their own. But to thousands of poor students in Quezon City, regular access to reading materials can only come from public libraries such as the Quezon City Public Library;
