RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5762, S-2013

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO DOLLAR TRANSPORT, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF AN AUTOGAS/LPG DISPENSER TO BE LOCATED AT MATAHIMIK STREET, BARANGAY MALAYA, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilor JULIAN ML. COSETENG.

Co-Introduced by Councilors Precious Hipolito Castelo, Alexis R. Herrera, Eufemio C. Iagumbay, Godofredo T. Liban II and Ramulfo Z. Ludovica.

WHEREAS, petitioner, Dollar Transport, Inc., a business entity duly registered under Philippine laws, is applying for a Special Use Permit (SUP) to be used for the construction and operation of an Autogas/LPG dispenser located at Matahimik Street, Barangay Malaya, District IV, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, fuel stations are among the uses that require a Special Use Permit upon authorization from the Quezon City Council as provided in Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, otherwise known as the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2000, as amended;

WHEREAS, Dollar Transport, Inc. has complied with the necessary requirements for the issuance of a Special Use Permit as mandated by the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the construction and operation of an Autogas/LPG dispenser will provide employment and promote economic development in the City.
