WHEREAS, the Office of the Vice Mayor in close partnership with the University of the Philippines-National College of Public Administration and Governance (UP-NCPAG) conducted the 3rd Quezon City Youth Summit last August 17, 2013 at Don Alejandro Roces, Sr. Science-Technology High School, Quezon City; ✓

WHEREAS, five hundred thirty one (531) youth leaders representing various sectors such as the Sangguniang Kabataan; barangay-based, community-based, faith-based and school-based organizations; the out-of-school, and youth with special needs, participated in the Youth Summit;

WHEREAS, the Youth Summit was constituted in order to provide a venue through which the youth of Quezon City could collectively review and assess the state of youth representation and participation in their communities, and make recommendations in order to better achieve the objective of harnessing and developing their talents, skills, and idealism towards effective nation building;

WHEREAS, in order to realize this goal, it is necessary to review the provisions embodied in the 1991 Local Government Code relative to the Katipunan ng Kabataan and the Sangguniang Kabataan, which are the legal framework for youth representation and participation in governance, as well as the mechanisms enabling and governing youth participation and representation as a whole;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government deems it necessary to adopt the Manifesto and Recommendations derived from the Youth Summit in order to affirm the youth's aspirations for themselves and their sector, and to fortify our collective commitment in addressing the issues that bear on youth participation and representation in governance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to adopt, as it does hereby adopt the 3rd Quezon City Youth Summit Manifesto and Recommendations and endorsing the same to the President of the Republic of the Philippines, the Senate President, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Chairpersons of the Committee on Local Government of both Houses of Congress and other concerned agencies.
