RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5793, S-2013,

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, TO PURCHASE ONE (1) UNIT OF ASIAN UTILITY VEHICLE (AUV) IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND (PH1,400,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR INTENDED FOR MONITORING OF VARIOUS PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR.

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160 provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Office of the Mayor is requesting the purchase of one (1) unit of Asian Utility Vehicle (AUV) amounting to One Million Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1,400,000.00) with description/specification of the motor vehicle are as follows:

- Color: Thermalyte (Silver);
- 4-Speed Automatic Gate-Type and 5 Speed Manual Transmission,
Rack and pinion with power;
- Steering this vehicle with overall curb weight of 1,580 Kg (AT) supported by a 205/65 R15 6JJx15" Alloy with Center Cup/ with a maximum output of 136PS/5,600 rpm and a maximum torque of 182NM/4,000 rpm;
- New audio system with WMA Compatibility and Auxiliary Input;
- Dual Front SRS Airbags, seatbelts with DR and Front Passenger Seatbelt warning;
- Child Lock Protector, Side Color Impact Beams and ABS;
- With Tint, Matting, Seat Cover. 10 Liters of Fuel;
- Gasoline;
- Three (3) Years Land Transportation Office Registration; and
- Warranty: For Three (3) Years of 100,000 kms whichever comes first

WHEREAS, the purchase of the said vehicle shall be utilized for the monitoring of various programs and projects including the official use of the Office of the Mayor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 15 amending Administrative Order No. 233 Series of 2008, the Honorable Mayor Herbert M. Bautista has already sought permission and authorization from the Department of the Interior and Local Government in relation to the procurement of the abovementioned vehicle amounting to One Million Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1,400,000.00) which is included in the 2012 Annual General Budget of the Quezon City Government under the Office of the City Mayor.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the purchase of one (1) Asian Utility Vehicle by the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista in the amount of One Million Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (Ph1,400,000.00) to be taken from the funds of the Office of the City Mayor intended for monitoring of various programs and projects of the Quezon City Government under the Office of the City Mayor. ✓
