WHEREAS, Section 16, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that: "The State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature";

WHEREAS, Section 5 (b) of the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999, define Air pollution as any alternation of the physical, chemical and biological properties of the atmospheric air, or any discharge thereto of any liquid, gaseous or solid substances that will or is likely to create or to render the air resources of the country harmful, detrimental, or injurious to public health, safety or welfare or which will adversely affect their utilization for domestic, commercial, industrial, agricultural, recreational, or other legitimate purposes:

WHEREAS, cars and petroleum run vehicles have been identified as the largest contributor of air pollution in the world; y

WHEREAS, according to World Health Organization, one of the top ten leading causes of death in the world is respiratory infections, chronic obstructive lung disease caused by air pollution;

WHERIAS, e-jeepney and e-tricycle does not consume either gasoline or diesel to operate because it run on pure electricity supplied by rechargeable automotive butteries, thus no harmful emissions, noise or fumes coming from electronic vehicles;

WHEREAS, e-jeepney and e-tricycle have numerous advantages compared to traditional fueled vehicles, to wit: zero maintenance, provide security to drivers, more stable electric prices and environmental friendly;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the city and the welfare of its constituent: to make a cleaner, greener, safer and economical way by patronizing eco-friendly motor vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Local Government of Quezon City to consider using E-jeepneys and E-tricycles for its various monitoring activities and for other purposes.
