**A RESOLUTION URGING THE SCHOLARSHIP AND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (SYDP) UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR TO ALLOCATE COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS TO QUALIFIED PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES RESIDING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY THROUGH THE CREATION OF GUIDELINES TOGETHER WITH THE QUEZON CITY PERSONS WITH DISABILITY AFFAIRS OFFICE (QC-PDAO).**

*WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels, and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;*

*WHEREAS, Section 2, Paragraph 3 of the same provides that the State shall establish and maintain a system of scholarship grants, student loan programs, subsidies, and other incentives which shall be available to deserving students in both public and private schools, especially to the under-privileged;*

*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council, through Ordinance No. 2085, Series of 2011, created the Quezon City Persons with Disability Affairs Office (QC-PDAO) in order to hear and address the concerns of Persons with Disabilities (PWDs);*

WHEREAS, by virtue of City Council Resolution No. 577, Series of 1991, the Quezon City government, under the Office of the City Mayor, created the Scholarship and Youth Development Program (SYDP) pursuant to the state's policies cited above;

WHEREAS, the SYDP provides financial assistance through scholarships to qualified beneficiaries, provided that they belong to indigent and displaced families of the city and maintains a general weighted average of 2.5 or the equivalent to the grade with no failing grade;


WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the city and the well-being of its constituents to provide appropriate steps to make education accessible to all including persons with disabilities such as but not limited to the visually impaired, hearing impaired, and attention deficit disorder (ADD);

WHEREAS, the SYDP provides scholarships to persons with disabilities pending a set of guidelines for the distribution of said scholarships.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Scholarship and Youth Development Program (SYDP) under the Office of the City Mayor to allocate College Scholarship Funds to qualified persons with disabilities residing within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City through the creation of guidelines together with the Quezon City Persons with Disability Affairs Office (QC-PDAO).
