A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO LOOK INTO AND REQUEST PROPOSALS IN ESTABLISHING A MEDICAL OXYGEN GENERATOR PLANT IN QUEZON CITY IN CONSONANCE WITH HIS SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC THRUSTS.

WHEREAS, in his second term of being elected as Mayor of Quezon City, his thrust shifted to economic programs, that would deal with the development of new industries and provide the city with income;

WHEREAS, annually, millions of pesos are allocated for the purchase of Medical Oxygen by the Quezon City-maintained hospitals such as the Quezon City General Hospital and Novaliches District Hospital, yet there are reports that our poor constituents are asked to pay for the use of oxygen supply;
