WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II, of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall promote and protect the intellectual well-being of the youth;

WHEREAS, there is a serious concern regarding the decline in the literacy rate among the youth residing within the territory of the City;

WHEREAS, along with the decline in the literacy rate is the downward trend in the utilization of libraries in the City;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned phenomena is largely attributed to poverty and inaccessibility of facilities and resources, that is, people would rather spend money on food than on books and going to the library;

WHEREAS, steps have been taken to address this problem, such as Efren Peñaflorida's "Kariton Klasrum" and other such emulations like District II's mobile library, "MOLI;"

WHEREAS, these projects and programs are laudable in their efforts but still insufficient in addressing the whole of Quezon City;
