RESOLUTION NO. SP- **5935** , S-2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ), REPRESENTED BY SECRETARY LEILA O. DE LIMA, FOR THE MANAGEMENT, UTILIZATION, MAINTENANCE AND SECURITY OF THE "NEW DOJ BUILDING" FUNDED AND CONSTRUCTED BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT, LOCATED WITHIN THE QUEZON CITY HALL COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice is a government instrumentality created under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with principal office at Padre Faura Street, City of Manila;

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice is the government's principal law agency which serves as the prosecution arm and administers the government's criminal justice system;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (i) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that the City Mayor shall "allocate and assign office space to city and other officials and employees who, by law or ordinance, are entitled to such space in the city hall and other buildings owned or leased by the City Government";

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is the registered owner of a parcel of land known as the Quezon City Hall Complex covered by TCT No. RT-30112 (258840) of the Registry of Deeds of Quezon City described as Lot 6, Pcs-4564 containing an area of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Five Square Meters and Ninety Square Decimeters (120,005.90) located at Barangay Central, Diliman, Quezon City;


WHEREAS, to pursue the stipulations contained from the abovementioned provisions of the Local Government Code, the Quezon City Government has appropriated fund, developed and constructed a six (6)-storey building with mezzanine and roofdeck containing an aggregate floor area of Seven Thousand Two Hundred Ten (7,210) Square Meters, more or less, located within the Quezon City Hall Complex known as the "New DOJ Building" to be used exclusively for prosecution of crimes/offenses;

WHEREAS, Section 22 (c) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that, "unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned".

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Justice (DOJ), represented by Secretary Leila O. De Lima, for the management, utilization, maintenance and security of the "New DOJ Building" funded and constructed by the City Government, located within the Quezon City Hall Complex.


