A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY TOURISM DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT A CONSULTATIVE SUMMIT WITH TOUR OPERATORS, TRAVEL AGENTS, THE DIVISION OF CITY SCHOOLS AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS WITH THE OBJECTIVE OF CREATING ECONOMICAL EDUCATIONAL TOUR PACKAGES PROMOTING THE HISTORICAL, CULTURAL, HERITAGE, AND EDUCATIONAL SITES IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Constitution provides that the State shall conserve, promote, and popularize the historical and cultural heritage and resources of the nation;

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of 1991 the City Council is empowered to approve measures for the efficient and effective delivery of basic services including tourism development and promotion programs;

WHEREAS, the Department of Education Order No. 52, S. 2003 provides that field trips should be in educational places, such as cultural and historical sites or science exhibits in museums which complement or supplement classroom lessons;

WHEREAS, Quezon City has developed and maintained various historical and cultural heritage sites and educational centers such as, but not limited to, the Quezon Memorial Circle, Ninoy Aquino Parks and Wildlife, La Mesa Dam Eco Park, Quezon City Science Interactive Center, and the Quezon Heritage House;


WHEREAS, the expected output of the proposed summit is the creation of economical educational tour packages that will enhance our students' knowledge and instill a sense of pride in them;
