A RESOLUTION DONATING FORTY SEVEN (47) UNITS OF COMPUTER SETS AS PART OF THE EDUCATION ENHANCEMENT CAMPAIGN OF QUEZON CITY, PURCHASED THROUGH THE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR DOROTHY A. DELARMENTE, TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO TWELVE (12) PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS AND TWO (2) PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS AND THIRTY THREE (33) BARANGAYS IN DISTRICT 1, THIS CITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE SAID COMPUTER SETS TO THE RECIPIENTS WITHOUT COST TO THEM.

WHEREAS, a Deed of Donation will be executed with the recipients transferring the ownership of the said computer sets via donation, with the Local Government of Quezon City assuming all fees and dues therein.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to donate, as it does hereby donate forty seven (47) units of computer sets as part of Education Enhancement Campaign of Quezon City which were purchased through the funds of the Office of Councilor Dorothy A. Delarmente to be distributed to twelve (12) Public Elementary Schools and two (2) Public High Schools and thirty three (33) Barangays in District 1, this City, and authorizing the transfer of ownership of the said computer sets to the recipients without cost to them.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the ownership of the said computer sets be transferred to the recipients through a Deed of Donation to be signed by the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, Councilor Dorothy A. Delarmente and the Head of the City General Services Department (CGSD), Mr. Rolando P. Montiel.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution along with the executed Deed of Donation be furnished to the forty seven (47) recipients and the Office of Councilor Dorothy A. Delarmente.
