RESOLUTION NO. SP. **6826**, S-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY (QCPU) TO OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT WITH THE LAND BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (LBP) WITH ACCOUNT NAME: QCPU-SHS VP FOR THE TRANSFER OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL VOUCHER PAYMENTS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DEPED).

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-2308, S-2014 authorizes the Quezon City Polytechnic University (QCPU) to offer Senior High School Education beginning school year 2016-2017 until the end of school year 2020-2021 consistent with the rules and regulations of Republic Act No. 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013;


WHEREAS, QCPU through Permit Nos. SHS-0328, S-2016, SHS-0222, S-2016, and SHS-0013, S-2016 is authorized by the Department of Education to offer the Senior High School program;


WHEREAS, DepEd Order No. 38, S-2016 provides detailed guidelines on the implementation of the Senior High School (SHS) Voucher Program;

WHEREAS, the Senior High School Voucher Program (SHS VP) under the Department of Education is intended to provide students with greater choice in deciding the Senior High School program that is most relevant to their needs and career goals. It likewise aims to help decongest highly-populated public secondary schools by enabling students to enroll in eligible non-DepEd schools such as Private High Schools, Colleges, and Universities; Local Universities and Colleges (LUC); State Universities and Colleges (SUCs); and Technical and Vocational Schools;

WHEREAS, Section A No. 2 of DepEd Order No. 38, S-2016 states that "All SHS VP participating schools are required to open a bank account with Land Bank of the Philippines (LBP) where the voucher payments will be transferred. The basis for the opening of bank accounts shall be the SHS permits issued to non-DepEd schools;"

WHEREAS, DepEd requires schools with existing LBP accounts to open a separate account intended for voucher payments;


WHEREAS, the QCPU Board of Regents, through Resolution No. 3 Series of 2016, has approved a motion allowing QCPU to open a separate account with the Land Bank of the Philippines intended for the SHS Voucher payments. 




NOW, THEREFORE,


