A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE SINCEREST ADMIRATION AND COMMENDATION OF MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, VICE MAYOR MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE AND THE MEMBERS OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL TO THE THIRTEEN (13) FILIPINO ATHLETES IN THE 2016 RIO OLYMPICS.

WHEREAS, the following thirteen (13) Filipino athletes represented the Philippines in the 2016 Olympics, namely: table tennis player Ian Lariba, boxers Rogen Ladon and Charly Suarez, swimmers Jasmine Alkhaldi and Jessie Lacuna, track and field athletes Eric Cray, Marestella Torres-Sunang and Mary Joy Tabal, weightlifters Hidilyn Diaz and Nestor Colonia, judoka Kodo Nakano, and taekwondo jin Kirstie Alora and golfer Miguel Tabuena;

*WHEREAS, qualifying in the Olympic games require huge amount of determination and years of training, or athletes competed and were victorious in qualifying events organized by the International Federations governing their respective sports; **

WHEREAS, Miguel Tabuena is the Champion of the 2015 Philippine Open;

WHEREAS, Kirstie Alora is a Bronze Medalist in the 2010 (Guangzhou) and 2014 (Incheon) Asian Games. She qualified for the Rio Olympics as a Silver Medalist in the Asian Olympic Qualifying Tournament;

WHEREAS, Kodo Nakano is a Bronze Medalist in the 2013 Southeast Asian Judo Championships;

WHEREAS, Nestor Colonia is a Gold Medalist in the 2015 Asian Weightlifting Championships and a Bronze Medalist in the 2015 World Weightlifting Championships and 2016 Asian Weightlifting Championships;

WHEREAS, Hidilyn Diaz is a two-time Silver Medalist during the 2011 and 2013 Southeast Asian Games. A Bronze Medalist in the 2015 World Weightlifting Championships and a Gold Medalist in the 2015 Asian Weightlifting Championships;

WHEREAS, Mary Joy Tabal qualified for the Rio Olympics as the 8th place among 1,455 female runners in the Scotiabank Ottawa Marathon in Canada. She is a Silver Medalist in the 2015 Southeast Asian Games in Singapore;

WHEREAS, Marestella Torres-Sunang is a 4-time Gold Medalist in the 2005, 2007, 2009, 2011 Southeast Asian Games and a Gold Medalist in the 2009 Asian Athletics Championships;

WHEREAS, Eric Cray is a 3-time Gold Medalist in the 2013 and 2015 Southeast Asian Games and a Bronze Medalist in the 2016 Asian Indoor Athletics Championships;

WHEREAS, Jessie Lacuna is a two-time Silver Medalist in the 2009 and 2011 Southeast Asian Games;

WHEREAS, Jasmine Alkhaldi is a 5-time Bronze medalist in the 2013 and 2015 Southeast Asian Games;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizes and commends the relentless hardwork and determination of our Filipino athletes who bring honor to the country.


NOW, THEREFORE,


