RESOLUTION NO. SP **6837**, S 2016

A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING BARANGAY PALIGSAHAN, QUEZON CITY FOR THE EXEMPLARY PERFORMANCE OF THEIR BARANGAY PEACE AND ORDER COMMITTEE IN THE RECENTLY CONDUCTED 2015 BARANGAY PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL (BPOC) CROSS VALIDATION WITH A RATING OF NINETY NINE PERCENT (99%).

WHEREAS, Section 116 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and Executive Order No. 773, S. 2009, calls for the further reorganization of the Peace and Order Council, and every Province, City and Municipality is mandated to have a Peace and Order Council (POC);

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 366 provides that the Barangay Peace and Order Council (BPOC) is the implementing arm of the City/ Municipal Peace and Order Council to enhance the effectiveness of the Peace and Order Council (POC) in its crime prevention and suppression mission through the expansion of its membership and the extension of its infrastructure down to the barangay level;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the said Order states that the BPOC shall formulate plans, and recommend such measures, which will improve or enhance peace and order in their area of responsibility;

WHEREAS, the functions of BPOC are the following:

- a.) Initiate, coordinate and monitor the implementation of peace and order programs, projects and activities at the barangay level;
- b.) Serve as an information-gathering mechanism;
- c.) Monitor and check the nefarious activities of criminal elements;
- d.) Supervise barangay tanods in identifying barangay constituents with strong deviant behavior for referral to appropriate authorities;
- e.) Maintain continuing dialogue, close coordination and rapport with the City/Municipal Peace and Order Council, the City/Municipal Management Coordinating Committee and the law enforcement units operating in the barangay;
- f.) Formulate plans and recommend such measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety in its area of responsibility;
- g.) Supervise, coordinate and monitor the operations of all community-based anti-crime movements within the barangay;
- h.) Undertake periodic assessment of the prevailing peace and order situation in the barangay and submit reports with appropriate recommendations to the City/Municipal Peace and Order Council;
- i.) Perform such other functions that may be assigned by higher level peace and order councils

WHEREAS, last 21st of December 2015, Dir. Maria Lourdes L. Agustin, CESO V, OIC-Regional Director of the National Capital Region awarded the Certificate of Special Recognition to Barangay Paligsahan, Quezon City for garnering a 99% in the 2015 BPCC Cross Validation;

WHEREAS, the indicators in the 2015 BPOC Cross Validation are as follows:

- a.) Organization (10%)
- b.) Meetings (10%)
- c.) Policies, Plans and Budget (30%); and
- d.) Accomplishments (50%) of the BPOC of every barangay;


WHEREAS, the Special Recognition awarded to Barangay Paligsahan only shows that their BPOC are functional and responsive to the needs of the constituents;

WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper to commend Barangay Paligsahan, Quezon City, for being the First Place in the National Capital Region 2015 BPOC Cross Validation with an average of 99%.


NOW, THEREFORE,


