



RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6871** , S-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PROCURE FIFTY (50) UNITS OF MOTORIZED VEHICLE, TO BE DONATED AND UTILIZED BY THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT (QCPD), FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF THEIR OPERATIONS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that, "The City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

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WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C, S-2013, "requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursements charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made" citing the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisimbing vs Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (GR No 175527) of the Supreme Court as basis;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Police District mission and vision for our constituents is "to provide quality service which will make Quezon City an ideal community where people live, work and do business in a hospitable, progressive and peaceful environment.";

WHEREAS, Mayor Herbert M. Bautista has lauded the QCPD personnel for their valuable service to the Quezon City residents and he challenged them to work harder to maintain peace and order;

WHEREAS, the procurement and donation of the said motor vehicles for the QCPD are necessary to ensure their mobility and efficient response time, inspire the police force and as well as further show the Quezon city Government's support for the maintenance of peace, law and order;

WHEREAS, Mayor Herbert M. Bautista is authorized to procure Fifty (50) units of Motorized Vehicle to be donated and utilized by the Quezon City Police District (QCPD), for the effective implementation of their operations and law enforcement activities, subject to existing law, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the motor vehicles requested have the following make/description, to wit:

Project Title : Fifty (50) units of Motorized Vehicle



Specifications: Engine make/model: 1.3 Liter, 4-cylinder in-line DOHC, Dual VVT-I, 16-valve, EFI (Electronic Fuel Injection), 85 HP/6,000 RPM maximum output and a Torque of 122 NM/ 4,400 RPM, catalytic converter, 5-speed manual transmission, EURO 4 emission; Steering System: Electronic Power Steering (EPS), new Three (3) Stroke urethane; Interior: power window & door lock, fabric seat material, (new) analogue instrument panel, illuminated entry system, sun-visor, day & night rear view mirror, assist grip, seat back hook, moulded door trim with fabric, room lamp, front personal lamp, luggage room lamp, key & lamps remind warning; Audio System: manual dial; Exterior: 2-beam halogen headlamp, color-keyed with chrome radiator grill, black outer mirror & door outside handle, fender mounted side turn signal lamp, pole type antenna, rear window defogger, 175/65 R14 steel wheels, rear combination lamps, color-keyed rear license garnish; Suspension: front mcpherson strut with stabilizer, rear torsion beam; Safety: GOA body, dual SRS Airbag, 3 pt. ELR x 2 with pretensioner & force limiter front seatbelts (driver only) 3 pt ELR x 2 + 2 pt NR x 1 rear seatbelts, child lock protection, high mount stop lamp; Free Items: tint; seat cover, matting, undercoat, with Top Light Celltron, QCPD stickers, GPS Tracker, 3 year Registration; Warranty: for 3 years or 100,00 kms (whichever comes first) the Motorized Vehicle manufacturer/supplier /dealer shall either repair or replace FREE OF CHARGE any part that it manufactures/supplies that is in material of workmanship under normal use (This warranty is transferable to subsequent owner and shall be honored by the manufacturer/supplier/dealer.

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WHEREAS, the Purchase Request (PR) submitted to the Bids and Awards Committee is in accordance with law and will serve the best interest of the Quezon City Government.


NOW, THEREFORE,


