A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA TO UTILIZE THE OTHER MAINTENANCE AND OPERATING EXPENSES IN THE 2016 GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOOD, SERVICES, AND SUPPLIES, TO BE USED BY THE OFFICE OF THE VICE MAYOR.

WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by local government units (LGUs) shall be made through competitive public bidding;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of the same Code provides that the City Mayor shall represent that City in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C (2013), citing as basis the Supreme Court decision in the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisimbing vs. Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R. No. 175527), requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses or disbursements will be charged against a budget lump sum appropriation;

WHEREAS, the Office of the Vice Mayor is requesting the Quezon City Council to authorize the Quezon City Mayor to purchase the following items, to wit:



NOW, THEREFORE,


