A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT THROUGH CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS OF AGREEMENT WITH THE WINNING BIDDERS AND/OR CONTRACTORS OF THE VARIOUS INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, General Rule in Procurement or Disposal. - Except as otherwise provided herein, acquisition of supplies and services by local government units shall be through competitive public bidding. x.x.x;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b), (1), (vi) of the same Code states that, "The City Mayor shall represent the City in all business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligation, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

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
NOW, THEREFORE,
