RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6976**, S-2017




A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, WITH THE MAGNA ANIMA EDUCATION SYSTEM AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – DIVISION OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PERFORMING ARTS, MEDIA ARTS, SPORTS, AND MARITIME TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL TRACKS UNDER THE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, DepEd-QC will start the full implementation of Senior High School (SHS) in School Year 2016-2017, and to achieve this objective, it necessitate to enter into partnership with Magna Anima Education System;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8525, otherwise known as the "Adopt-A-School Act 1998" was enacted to encourage private companies to assist in the delivery of better quality education to public schools in the country, the assistance of which includes among others the provision of staff and faculty development for training and further education and modernization of instructional technologies; *

WHEREAS, BIR Revenue Regulation No. 10, Series of 2003 was likewise issued providing guidelines in implementing the tax incentives provisions of Republic Act No. 8522 that may be availed of by the private companies;

WHEREAS, LGU-QC, DepEd and Magna having established similar goals and plans in quality education, mutually decided to lay the groundwork for the establishment and implementation of the Senior High School Program Tracks in the fields of Sports, Media Arts, Performing Arts and Maritime Technical-Vocational at identified beneficiary schools;

WHEREAS, LGU-QC and Magna have come to an agreement regarding the partnership for the implementation of the Senior High School Program Tracks;

WHEREAS, due to the lack of permanent school heads, facilities and/or space at the previously assigned school beneficiaries, DepEd-QC sees the need to include other public high schools as the head and/or facility project beneficiaries of the SHS Tracks, namely: Jose P. Laurel High School, Quezon City High School, San Francisco High School and Ismael Mathay Sr. High School;

WHEREAS, among the salient provisions of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) are the following:

Both DepEd-QC and Magna:

- Create a SHS Working Group (SHSWG) under the project management team that will prepare the action plan to operate and monitor the progress of the partnership and make sure that the provisions of the MOA are met;
- Develop the student's work immersion module and make the needed adjustments to contextualize the SHS courses

DepEd-QC shall:

- Be open to consult, guide, and assist the Senior High Schools in the implementation of the SHS Tracks; †

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
- Assist Magna in implementing the SHS Tracks;
- Recommend for approval of the Specialized and Applied Courses based on the prescribed curriculum provided by DepEd-QC;
- Ensure that SHS exercise their responsibility as diligent parents to ensure the safety and well-being of all students;
- Supply the necessary staff for the SHS Tracks through the school-project beneficiaries. However, Magna will not be precluded from introducing its own independent staff during the terms of the MOA before the Transfer of the facilities. The DepEd-QC faculty for the Specialized and Applied Courses shall be trained by Magna but will follow the employment policies of DepEd-QC;
- Support and provide the necessary permits to participants in the training provided by Magna Enrichment Program;
- Ensure that respective High School Principals provide and supervise the DepEd-QC faculty for the Core Courses and provide the list of qualified faculty who will teach the Specialized and Applied Courses who shall undergo the Magna Enrichment Program;

Ensure that respective High School Principals schedule the Core Courses for the seamless delivery of all SHS Courses and assist in the scheduling of Fellows and DepEd-QC Faculty for the Specialized and Applied Courses, in coordination with Magna;

- Provide Magna the names of Administrators, Faculty and Staff which will be trained for the administration and operation of SHS Tracks facilities; ✓




- *Retain the Principals of the Schools involved in this agreement to remain in their assigned school throughout the training duration unless the Principal is moved due to promotion or for other reasons, and in the exigencies of the service, with notice to Magna;*
- *Retain the DepEd-QC faculty participating in the Magna Enrichment Program unless the Teacher is moved due to promotion or for other reasons, and in the exigencies of the service, with notice to Magna;*
- *Oversee the maintenance and operation of the SHS Academic Buildings;*
- *Ensure that the High School Principals coordinate with the respective Elementary School Principals for the use of the interim building by the SHS Tracks while the permanent buildings/facilities are under construction and also assign the necessary rooms as required by Faculty, Students, Administrators and Staff;*
- *Ensure that Principals apply the relevant curricula, programs and rules necessary to implement the Senior High School Program;*
- *Ensure that the Senior High Schools monitor each student's progress throughout the entire immersion program;*
- *Ensure that the funds provided by LGU-QC for the implementation of its SHS Program Tracks shall be only used for that purpose;*
- *Facilitate the documentation and permits for the donation of facilities and equipment, including improvement; **



- *Ensure proper booking-up of any property or items received as donation, through coordination with the Supply Officer of the School or of the Division Office and include in its yearly budget a fund allotment for supplies and equipment needed for the SHS Program Tracks;*
- *Facilitate and ensure that such donations and training of the DepEd-QC Faculty and Staff are documented under the Adopt-A-School Program;*
- *Execute a Deed of Acceptance from the adopting entities;*
- *Review, facilitate or endorse the application of the adopting private entity for tax incentive or tax exemption entitlement to the corresponding Revenue District Office;*
- *Provide proper management, maintenance, and care for the support/intervention received by the beneficiary school, through the School Head/Principal, in close coordination within the adopting entity.*

Magna shall:

- *Develop and submit the enhanced curriculum and course description for the Specialized and Applied Courses for the SHS Tracks;*
- *Hire, supervise and provide the honoraria of the Fellows and Guest Lecturers for the Specialized and Applied Courses of the SHS Tracks;*



- *Supervise the Fellows in training DepEd-QC Faculty and coordinate with the SHS involved in the Specialized and Applied Courses;*
- *Conduct Magna Enrichment Program in preparation for the independent administration and operation after the transfer of the facilities to DepEd-QC;*
- *Coordinate the selection and assignment with DepEd-QC Faculty and propose its preferred or ideal qualifications, skill set or competencies of the SHS Principals and Faculty for the Specialized and Applied Courses;*
- *Provide an orientation for a holistic understanding of the business and recommend local school work immersion policies guidelines of student trainees;*
- *Recommend to DepEd-QC the graduates of the school in providing employment opportunities;*
- *Execute a Deed of Donation in favor of DepEd-QC For the completed delivery of the support;*
- *Submit to the Adopt-A-School Program Secretariat all pertinent documents in support to the amount specified/claimed for tax incentive application.*

LGU-QC shall:

- *Coordinate closely with DepEd-QC of their needs and requirements for the continuous implementation of the SHS Program Tracks; ✓*






- Support DepEd-QC in sourcing out funds to address the needs and requirements of the SHS Program Tracks;
- Ensure to include in its yearly budget a fund allotment for the allowance of employed instructors under the DepEd-QC teaching the Specialized and Applied Courses of the SHS Program Tracks;
- Disburse on time and regularly the funds from the fiscal allotment in its yearly budget, as required by the school for the implementation of the SHS Program Tracks;
- Construct perimeter fence for the SHS Academic Buildings to separate the SHS Buildings from the Elementary School Buildings and to have its own ingress and egress for use of the SHS Students, Faculty, Staff and Administrators.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panglungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, with the Magna Anima Education System and the Department of Education- Division of Quezon City for the implementation of the Performing Arts, Media Arts, Sports, and Maritime Technical – Vocational Tracks under the Senior High School Program. ✓




