RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6977**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP600,000) TO ROTARY CLUB OF KAMUNING DISTRICT 3780 ASSOCIATION, INC., SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Kamuning located at RI District 3780 Roces Avenue corner Mother Ignacia Street, Quezon City is a community service club affiliated with Rotary International District 3780, Quezon City and as such, has been undertaking its signature service project every year since 1994, dubbed as the "Alay ng Rotary sa Araw ng Kabataan" (ALAY), where 3,000 to 4,000 elementary and high school students from the different public schools in Quezon City participate yearly to compete in various Philippine cultural, music, and arts activities;

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Kamuning is an organization duly accredited with the Quezon City Community Relations Office (CRO);

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2016, the Office of the City Mayor informed the said organization through a letter addressed to its President that he has granted the amount of Six Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php600,000.00) as financial assistance to help defray the expenses of the project;

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2016, the 19th City Council, through this representation, filed a Proposed Resolution docketed as PR19CC-1406, S-2016 to grant authority to the City Mayor to extend this financial assistance; however, it was not approved due to the adjournment of the City Council for the upcoming 2017 National and Local Elections;


WHEREAS, Section 36 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" expressly provides:

"Section 36. Assistance to People's and Non-Governmental Organizations. - A local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental, or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction."


NOW, THEREFORE,
