RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6989**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SIXTY ONE PESOS AND TWENTY CENTAVOS (PHP 1,138,161.20) TO FUND THE PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE QUEZON CITY LADIES FOUNDATION INC. TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, AID AND SUBSIDIES UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR IN THE 2016 ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS.

*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Ladies Foundation, Inc. formerly known as the Quezon City Associated Ladies Foundation, is a non-stock, non-profit organization at the forefront of the community service in Quezon City, Philippines. It was registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) on September 5, 2007 bearing Company Registration No. CN200713618 and Company TIN No. 006-866-785;*

*WHEREAS, its vision is to unite and inspire the women of Quezon City toward achieving the highest ideals of community service;*

WHEREAS, more than a thousand strong leadership is composed of women community leaders from all over the City headed by the wives of the elected Quezon City Officials;


WHEREAS, the Foundation's priority projects are focused on health, education, livelihood, issue advocacy and human rights which are geared primarily towards addressing the needs of the City's women and children;

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill their mandate and sustain its operation, there is a need to fund the administrative and activity expenses.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend financial assistance in behalf of the Quezon City Government in the amount of One Million One Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand One Hundred Sixty One Pesos and Twenty Centavos (PHP1,138,161.20) to fund the projects and activities of the Quezon City Ladies Foundation, Inc. to be taken from the appropriation for grants, aid and subsidies under the Office of the City Mayor in the 2016 Annual Budget of Quezon City or from any available funds.
