
RESOLUTION NO. SP. 6997 __, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION PESOS (PHP1,000,000.00) TO FUND THE PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (QCPSTA) FOR THE YEAR 2017 TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, AIDS AND SUBSIDIES UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR IN THE 2017 ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the (QCPSTA) Quezon City Public School Teachers Association is the official and duly recognized organization of teachers and non-teaching personnel under the Division of City Schools-Quezon City, Philippines. The QCPSTA is recognized by the

Philippine Public School Teachers Association as their local affiliated chapter and the QCPSTA President, Dr. Priscilla D. Ampuan, is a regular member of the Quezon City Local School Board. The QCPSTA is also an affiliated chapter of the Alliance of Concerned Teachers (ACT). ACT is a member of Education International (EI);

WHEREAS, the QCPTSA have a total number of Fifteen Thousand Four Hundred One (15,401) members, this includes Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Five (13,485) teachers and One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixteen (1,916) non-teaching personnel;

WHEREAS, the QCPSTA have a total number of One Hundred Forty Three (143) member schools, Ninety Seven (97) Elementary Schools and Forty Six (46) High Schools;

WHEREAS, the QCPSTA declared principles and objective is to promote the rights and welfare of public school teachers and employees and work for an educational system that contributes to the realization of a just, free, democratic, peaceful and prosperous Philippines.

WHEREAS, QCPTSA have an ongoing welfare programs such as The QCPSTA Death Aid Contribution System (DACS), Free Annual Medical Check-Up, Rice Subsidy Allowance, Retired Teachers Medical Assistance Program and Medical Assistance Fund for Seriously Ill Members.

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill their mandate and defray the cost of annual medical examination of their members as well as other major activities of the organization, there is a need to fund the administrative and activity expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend

financial assistance, in behalf of the Quezon City Government, in the amount of One Million Pesos (PHP1,000,000.00) to fund the projects and activities of the Quezon City Public School Teachers Association (QCPSTA) to be taken from the appropriation for grants, aid and subsidies under the Office of the City Mayor in the 2017 Annual Budget of Quezon City or from any available funds.
