A RESOLUTION URGING ALL THE BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY TO PROVIDE FREE ACCESS TO GOVERNMENT ONLINE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates every local government to promote the general welfare of its constituents and "encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities" ;

WHEREAS, as the basic political unit, the barangay serves as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans, programs, projects and activities in the community;

WHEREAS, various government agencies such as the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth), Home Development Mutual Fund (PAG-IBIG Fund), Government Service Insurance System (GSIS), and the Social Security System (SSS) provide online services such as membership registration, records verification, and online application for availment of benefits; †

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WHEREAS, despite the fact that almost each Filipino owns at least one phone or mobile device, a significant portion of the population still do not benefit from Internet access, which impedes access to online public services and benefits;


WHEREAS, the provision of free access to government online services in all Barangays in Quezon City will support the technological capabilities of the disadvantaged and enhance their access to government services.

NOW, THEREFORE,




