RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7057**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (FIRST PARTY), REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS-NCR (SECOND PARTY), REPRESENTED BY REGIONAL DIRECTOR, ENGR. REYNALDO G. TAGUDANDO, FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUND FROM THE SECOND PARTY TO THE FIRST PARTY AMOUNTING TO SEVENTEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY PESOS (PHP17,502,960.00), EARMARKED FOR THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF THE SIX HUNDRED TWENTY SIX (626) INFORMAL SETTLER FAMILIES (ISFs) TO BE AFFECTED BY THE IBP ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, SPECIFICALLY IBP ROAD SEGMENT FROM STATION 19+840 (SAMPAGUITA STREET) TO STATION 20+800 (ILANG-ILANG STREET), SITUATED IN AREA-A, BARANGAY PAYATAS, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Second Party is tasked to undertake the implementation of the Improvement/Widening of the segment of IBP Road, specifically Station 19+840 to Station 20+800 (from Sampaguita Street to Ilang-Ilang Street), equivalent to 960 linear meters, situated in Area-A, Barangay Payatas, Quezon City, which Road Improvement Project will affect about 626 on-site informal settler families (ISFs);

WHEREAS, to implement the said road improvement project, it will require the clearing/removal of ISFs' structures along the IBP Road Right-of-Way (RROW), particularly on the road segment described above;

WHEREAS, in line with this task and pursuant to the provision of Section 28 of Republic Act No. 7279, otherwise known as the Urban Development and Housing Act (UDHA), in lieu of relocation, financial assistance of Php27,960.00 per family (equivalent to the current minimum wage for sixty days) shall be provided to the affected ISFs;

WHEREAS, for the purpose of providing the financial assistance fund necessary to implement the clearing/removal of ISFs' structures on the above described RROW, the SECOND PARTY has allocated the amount of Seventeen Million Five Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty Pesos (Php17,502,960.00);


WHEREAS, like in many project-partnerships with the SECOND PARTY before, the FIRST PARTY has agreed to undertake the clearing/removal of the 626 structures that will be affected by the aforementioned road improvement project;

WHEREAS, to realize the implementation of the project, which would start with the clearing of the project site, the Parties herein entered into a Memorandum Agreement (MOA) for the transfer of the Financial Assistance Fund of Php17,502,960.00 from the Second Party to the First Party, a copy of said MOA, which was notarized by Atty. Agustin B. Cabredo, a Notary Public, and entered in his notarial record as Doc. No. 2, Page-1, Book No. 3 on August 12, 2015, is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Quezon City Council to ratify the MOA entered into by and between the herein FIRST PARTY and SECOND PARTY, so as to confirm the authority of the FIRST PARTY in the Agreement, as required under Section 3.1, Article III of the MOA, specifically on "Responsibility and Warranties".


NOW, THEREFORE,




