RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7060**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) ENTERED INTO BY BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, QUEZON CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION, REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT DR. PRISCILLA D. AMPUAN, AND ALLIANCE OF CONCERNED TEACHERS-PHILIPPINE INC. REPRESENTED BY ITS NATIONAL CHAIRPERSON MR. BENJAMIN G. VALBUENA FOR THE USE OF THE MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING LOCATED IN AN OPEN SPACE ALONG MINES STREET, NEAR MINES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, BARANGAY VASRA, QUEZON CITY, FOR A PERIOD OF TEN (10) YEARS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is a Local Government Unit organized and existing by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office and postal address at Quezon City Hall, Elliptical Road, Barangay Central, 1100, represented by its City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Public School Teachers Association is an organization of both teaching and non-teaching personnel in the public educational system of Quezon City, duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) with Registration No. 15504, represented by its President, Dr. Priscilla D. Ampuan;

WHEREAS, the Alliance of Concerned Teachers-Philippine Inc. is a non-stock, non-profit people's organization that works for the welfare of both the teaching and non-teaching personnel in the education sector nationwide duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission with Registration No. 0108727 represented by its National Chairperson, Mr. Benjamin G. Valbuena;

WHEREAS, in 2002, Bayan Muna Party List has allocated an amount of Two Million Pesos (Php2,000,000.00) for the construction of the Multi-Purpose Building to house the offices of the Quezon City Public School Teachers Association and the Alliance of Concerned Teachers-Philippine Inc. and in 2010, ACT Teachers Partylist had allocated an additional amount of Two Million Pesos (Php2,000,000.00) for the construction of permanent improvements;

WHEREAS, in 2004, the Quezon City Government has provided the land needed for the construction and in 2009, allocated the amount of Two Million Pesos (Php2,000,000.00) for the construction of the third floor Conference Hall and repainting of the building;

WHEREAS, the parties have signed the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on 21 December 2016 subject to the terms and conditions set forth therein.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) entered into by and between the Quezon City Government, represented by the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, Quezon City Public School Teachers Association, represented by its President Dr. Priscilla D. Ampuan and




