RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7061**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, QUEZON CITY, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF PANDI (MGP) AND NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY (NHA), FOR THE ONE TIME ALLOCATION AND TRANSFER OF TWENTY MILLION PESOS (PHP20,000,000.00) FROM QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG) TO MGP, EARMARKED AS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF PANDI, BULACAN.

WHEREAS, under the National Relocation Program and upon the request of the Quezon City Government (QCG), the National Housing Authority (NHA) has approved and accepted the relocation of qualified informal settler families (ISFs) from Quezon City to its various resettlement sites located in the Municipality of Pandi, Bulacan;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Pandi (MGP) has agreed and allowed receiving ISFs-relocatees from Quezon City to the NHA resettlement sites located within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the MGP, due to its limited resources, has requested the National Government to provide the much needed basic services and facilities in the various NHA resettlement sites in Pandi, Bulacan;

WHEREAS, in view of the National Government's constraint in appropriating funds for the immediate provision of the necessary basic services and facilities in the identified resettlement sites, the QCG, upon representations of the NHA, has agreed for the one time allocation and


transfer of Twenty Million Pesos (Php20,000,000.00) as financial assistance to the Quezon City informal settler families (ISFs) relocated to Pandi, Bulacan;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Quezon City Council to authorize the allocation and transfer of fund from QCG to MGP, earmarked for the provision of basic services and facilities to its resettled ISFs in Pandi, Bulacan, which fund may cover the expenses for the improvement of resettlement sites, acquisition of lots for and construction of social infrastructure facilities such as multi-purpose centers, acquisition of service vehicles and garbage truck, skills training, livelihood, as well as education and health services programs.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, Quezon City, to enter into a Memorandum Of Agreement (MOA) with Municipal Government of Pandi (MGP) and National Housing Authority (NHA), for the allocation and transfer of a total amount of Twenty Million Pesos (Php20,000,000.00) for a period of three years, from Quezon City Government (QCG) to MGP, earmarked as financial assistance to the Quezon City informal settler families (ISFs) relocated to Pandi, Bulacan.


