RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7067**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION URGING THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA) AND THE LAND TRANSPORTATION FRANCHISING AND REGULATORY BOARD (LTFRB) TO DEPUTIZE THE QUALIFIED MEMBERS OF REGISTERED AND ACCREDITED NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs) WHO DESIRE TO SERVE AS VOLUNTARY ENFORCERS OF THEIR RESPECTIVE AGENCIES.

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) is tasked to enforce traffic Laws, Rules and Regulations within the Metropolis;

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) is empowered to issue franchise or permit to operate to Public Utility Vehicles (PUV) such as the buses, jeepneys, taxi cabs, and school service and to apprehend them for violation of such privilege;

WHEREAS, traffic violations and congestions, road accidents, overcharging of fares, contracting of or discourtesy to passengers, and the like are mostly perpetrated by abusive and erring PUV drivers;

WHEREAS, due to limited number of MMDA and LTFRB personnel, particularly those assigned in the enforcement of their principal mandate, abusive and erring PUV drivers continue to proliferate to the prejudice of the helpless riding public;


WHEREAS, the deputization of qualified NGO members, either as MMDA or LTFRB Enforcers, will certainly help the two agencies in monitoring or apprehending the activities of abusive and erring PUV drivers;

WHEREAS, there are so many NGO members who are willing to share their time and, in fact, even their own resources to assist the government in the performance of their public duties provided they are properly deputized so that their acts would have a semblance of authority;

WHEREAS, prior to deputization, the qualified NGO members shall undergo the necessary orientation, seminar or training to enhance their knowledge about traffic Laws, Rules and Regulations and to teach them the proper procedure and courtesy in apprehending the violators.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) and the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) to deputize the qualified members of registered and accredited Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) who desire to serve as voluntary enforcers of their respective agencies. ✕




