A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE PASSAGE OF SENATE BILL NO. 1182, ENTITLED, "AN ACT DEFINING THE VISION AND POLICIES OF GOVERNMENT IN THE HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT, DEFINING ITS MANDATE, POWERS AND FUNCTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 9, Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution stipulates that "The State shall, by law, and for the common good, undertake, in cooperation with the private sector, a continuing program of urban land reform and housing which will make available at affordable cost, decent housing and basic services to underprivileged and homeless citizens in urban centers and resettlement areas. It shall also promote adequate employment opportunities to such citizens. In the implementation of such program the State shall respect the rights of small property owners.";

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1182, declares that, the State shall pursue the realization of a modern, humane, economically viable and environmentally sustainable society where the urbanization process is manifest in towns and cities being centers of productive economic


activity, led by market forces, where urban areas provide the opportunities for an improved quality of life and the eradication of poverty, and where there is a high degree of complementarity between urban and rural communities;

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1182 mandates the creation of Department of Housing and Urban Development. This agency will be the foremost mechanism of the government in ensuring the availability of affordable housing. Further, it shall be the lead agency in formulating all housing and urban development policies, plans, programs and projects for the Filipino people.


NOW, THEREFORE,
