*WHEREAS, petitioner Triple 8 Entertainment Company, a business entity duly registered under Philippine laws, is applying for a Special Permit for the operation of Electronic Games and Electronic Bingo located at Caswynn Building, No. 134 Timog Avenue, Quezon City;*

*WHEREAS, operating an Electronic Games and Electronic Bingo are among the business that require a Special Permit upon authorization from the Quezon City Council in accordance with the provisions of Article VII, Section 2 of Ordinance No. SP-2200, S-2013, otherwise known as the Revised Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;* ¶

WHEREAS, Triple 8 Entertainment Company has complied with the necessary requirements for the issuance of a Special Permit as mandated by the aforementioned Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the issuance of a Special Permit to Triple 8 Entertainment Company for the operation of Electronic Games and Electronic Bingo at No. 134 Timog Avenue, Quezon City.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that PAGCOR licensed E-Bingo Games shall remit to the City Treasurer a Franchise Fee of three percent (3%) of the gross sales of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the authority herein granted shall be for a period of two (2) years and maybe renewed by the City Council.
