RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7115**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ENTERED INTO AND SIGNED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, AND THE SEOUL METROPOLITAN FIRE AND DISASTER HEADQUARTERS, REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT, KWON SOON-KYUNG AND THE CITYNET SECRETARIAT, REPRESENTED BY ITS SECRETARY GENERAL, VIJAY JAGANNATHAN FOR THE HAND-OVER OF TWO (2) UNITS OF FIRE ENGINES, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that, "The City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

WHEREAS, the Seoul Metropolitan Fire and Disaster Headquarters (SFDHQ) is an agency of the Seoul Metropolitan Government in charge of fire and rescue services;

WHEREAS, Citynet is a regional network of over 130 cities and organizations specializing in sustainable urban development. The Citynet Secretariat manages the programs and institutional activities of the network to promote the exchange of knowledge, skills and techniques through four major program areas: training programs, seminars and forums, technical advisory services (TAS), and technical cooperation among cities of developing countries (TCDC).

WHEREAS, the Seoul Metropolitan Fire and Disaster Headquarters (SFDHQ) in cooperation with the Quezon City Government (QCG) and the Citynet Secretariat signed a Memorandum of Understanding donating Two (2) repaired and re-equipped fire engines to be utilized by the Quezon City Government (QCG);

WHEREAS, in view thereof, there is a need to ratify the Memorandum of Understanding signed by the parties and to authorize Honorable Herbert M. Bautista in his capacity as the Mayor of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby authorizes City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, for and in behalf of the Quezon City Government, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Understanding, with the Seoul Metropolitan Fire and Disaster Headquarters (SFDHQ) and the Citynet Secretariat.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify the Memorandum of Understanding entered into and signed by the Quezon City Government, represented by Mayor Herbert M. Bautista, and the Seoul Metropolitan Fire and Disaster Headquarters represented by its President, Kwon Soon-Kyung

and The Citynet Secretariat, represented by its Secretary General, Vijay Jagannathan for the hand-over of two (2) units Fire Engines, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Understanding entered into by and among:

SEOUL METROPOLITAN FIRE AND DISASTER HEADQUARTERS, an agency of the Seoul Metropolitan Government with address at 52 Toegye-ro26-gil, Jung-gu, Seoul, Republic of Korea, hereafter referred to as SFDHQ and represented herein by its President, **KWON SOON-KYUNG**;

QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, a public corporation created pursuant to Commonwealth Act 502, as amended, in relation to Republic Act 7160, as amended, with office address at Quezon City Hall, Elliptical Road, Barangay Central, Quezon City, Republic of the Philippines, hereafter referred to as QCG and represented herein by its City Mayor, **HERBERT M. BAUTISTA**; and

CITYNET SECRETARIAT, an entity duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of Korea, with office at 10F Seoul Global Center, 38 Jongno, Jongno-gu, Seoul, Republic of Korea, hereafter referred to as CITYNET and represented herein by its Secretary General, **VIJAY JAGANNATHAN**;

WITNESSETH, THAT:

WHEREAS, SFDHQ offered to hand over to QCG two fire engines which, although already decommissioned, would be fully repaired and re-equipped to make them usable and operational;

WHEREAS, QCG hereby accepts said offer with gratitude;

WHEREAS, CITYNET assisted in and made possible the coordination of the parties for the successful fire engine hand-over project;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. SFDHQ shall select from among decommissioned fire engines it owns two (2) fire engines which can be fully repaired and re-equipped to make the same usable and operational.
2. At its cost, SFDHQ shall fully repair and re-equip said selected fire engines to such acceptable level of efficiency and effectiveness.
3. SFDHQ shall, on its account, transport said fully repaired and re-equipped fire engines to the Philippines through a port of entry convenient thereto.
4. SFDHQ and CITYNET shall provide and send competent facilitators to Quezon City to train participants in a three (3)-day training program in the use and operation of the said fire engines. The airfare of the facilitators shall be shouldered and paid by each organization for their respective staffs.

5. SFDHQ shall execute and deliver to QCG a Deed of Donation indicating the technical descriptions of the said fire engines and provide QCG such necessary documentation as may be required for the importation and registration thereof.
6. QCG shall, on its account, settle all customs duties and charges on the said fire engines and at its cost bring the same to Quezon City.
7. QCG shall, on its account, make all arrangements for a three (3)-day training for the use and operation of said fire engines, including the venue, meals and refreshments, one (1) interpreter and other logistical requirements.
8. QCG shall shoulder the accommodation costs of the training facilitators for the duration of the training.
9. CITYNET shall ensure communication and coordination among the parties hereto for the successful implementation of the hand-over project.
10. CITYNET shall provide at least one facilitator with the appropriate competence for the training.
11. SFDHQ shall not be responsible for the loss or destruction of, or damage to the said fire engines while in transit to the Philippines or in its port by reason of force majeure or fortuitous event including acts of violence, terrorism or piracy nor shall it be held liable or responsible for death, injury or damage to any person or property by reason of, or during the conduct of the training.
12. After the execution of the Deed of Donation and the delivery to and acceptance by QCG of the said fire engines, QCG shall thenceforth maintain and repair said fire engines at its cost; provided that SFDHQ and CITYNET shall, by their best efforts, assist QCG in sourcing parts, materials, and supplies and technical services for the said purposes should the same be not readily available in the Philippines.
13. The parties hereto shall communicate with and give notice to each other on all matters pertaining to this MOU and the fire engine hand-over project through the following focal persons with their corresponding addresses:


