WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Police District (QCPD) mission and vision for its constituents is to "provide quality service which will make Quezon City an ideal community where people live, work and do business in a hospitable, progressive and peaceful environment";

WHEREAS, with the unassailable logistical support extended by the Quezon City Government to the Quezon City Police District (QCPD) in the form of patrol vehicles, modern police equipment and precinct facilities, our police force has responded positively by improving the crime solution efficiency, deterring the commission of street crimes by greater police visibility, and producing honest and helpful officers in our city among others;

WHEREAS, in the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisumbing vs. Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R. No. 175527), the Supreme Court requires the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursement charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council hereby authorizes the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to allow the procurement and to enter into a contract/agreement with the winning bidder on behalf of the Quezon City government for the Quezon City Police District such as One Thousand (1,000) pieces of Glock 17 9mm Gen 4 and Bullet Proof Vest Eight Hundred (800) pcs. subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.




NOW, THEREFORE,


