RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7146**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT (QCPD), IN COORDINATION WITH THE BARANGAY GOVERNMENTS, TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT ORDINANCE NO. SP-2163, S-2012, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF INTERNET CAFES OR COMPUTER RENTAL SHOPS/COMPUTER GAMING SHOPS IN QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF".

WHEREAS, as internet cafes, video and computer games shops proliferate, the Quezon City Government is one with parents, teachers and school officials in providing the appropriate environment for children's development;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-2163, S-2012 regulates the operation of internet cafes or computer rental shops/computer gaming shops in Quezon City;




WHEREAS, the said Ordinance mandates owners/ proprietors/managers of internet cafes and similar establishments to ensure that minors and/or students will not enter their shops during class hours and/or beyond 11:00 o'clock in the evening;

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the Ordinance mandates the Quezon City Police District (QCPD), the QC Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS), the Barangay Governments, in coordination with the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO), the Engineering Department, the Social Services Development Department (SSDD), and the Department of Education - Schools Division Office of Quezon City to implement the said measure;

WHEREAS, this Resolution aims to generate awareness on Ordinance No. SP-2163, S-2012 and urge its strict implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Quezon City Police District (QCPD), in coordination with the barangay governments, to strictly implement Ordinance No. SP-2163, S-2012, otherwise known as "An Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Internet Cafes or Computer Rental Shops/Computer Gaming Shops in Quezon City and Providing Penalties for Violation thereof".




