RESOLUTION NO. SP. 7152 , S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, IN FAVOR OF NAGA CITY, CAMARINES SUR AND CITY OF LIGAO, ALBAY, WHICH WERE SEVERELY AFFECTED BY TYPHOON "NINA", IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY MILLION PESOS (P20,000,000.00) AND TWENTY SEVEN MILLION PESOS, (P27,000,000.00) RESPECTIVELY, TO BE TAKEN FROM THE QUEZON CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND, REALLOCATING FUNDS AND INTENDED USE OF THE AMOUNT, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS AND RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Super Typhoon "Nina" (International name Nock-Ten) was considered the strongest typhoon ever to hit Region V (Bicol) in 2016 with a category #4 with maximum sustained winds of 130kph near the center and gustiness of up to 215kph that landfall on Tingloy, Batangas last December 26, 2016;

WHEREAS, among the places devastated by Super Typhoon "Nina" in Bicol Region were: City of Ligao, Albay and Naga City; Camarines Sur; ↓

WHEREAS, the QC Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council approved Resolution No. 003, S-2017, entitled "A Resolution Adopting Municipalities of Ligao Albay and Naga, Camarines Sur as sister Local Government Units (LGUs) to be provided with financial and other means of humanitarian support by the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, Ligao City Mayor Patty G. Alsua and Naga City Mayor John G. Bongat have written to the Hon. Herbert M. Bautista, Mayor of Quezon City requesting for financial assistance to be used in the repair and restoration of the various government infrastructure and facilities;

WHEREAS, in line with the aim of lending a helping hand and alleviating the lives of the people who were affected by typhoon "Nina" the following are the programs and detailed estimates for the proposed infrastructure projects damaged by Typhoon "Nina":

WHEREAS, Section 1, Rule 18 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10121 (The Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010) provides that upon the recommendation of the LDPPMC and approval of the Sanggunian concerned, the LDRRMCs may transfer the said fund to support the disaster risk reduction of other LDRRMCs which are declared under state of calamity.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend Financial Assistance, in favor of Naga City, Camarines Sur and City of Ligao, Albay, which were severely affected by Typhoon "Nina", in the amount of Twenty Million Pesos (P20,000,000.00) and Twenty Seven Million Pesos, (P27,000,000.00) respectively, to be taken from the Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund, reallocating funds and intended use of the amount, subject to existing laws and rules and regulations.
