RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7175**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION EIGHTY SEVEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FOURTEEN PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (PHP 1,087,914.50) TO FUND THE PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE QUEZON CITY LADIES FOUNDATION, INC. TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATION OF GRANTS, AIDS AND SUBSIDIES UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR IN THE 2017 ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, its vision is to unite and inspire the women of Quezon City toward achieving the highest ideals of community service;


WHEREAS, the foundation's priority projects are focused on health, education, livelihood, issue advocacy and human rights which are geared primarily towards addressing the needs of the City's women and children;

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill their mandate and operate, there is a need to fund the administrative and activity expenses.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend financial assistance in behalf of the Quezon City Government the amount of One Million Eighty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Pesos and Fifty Centavos (Php1,087,914.50) to fund the projects and activities of the Quezon City Ladies Foundation, Inc. to be taken from the appropriation of grants, aids and subsidies under the Office of the City Mayor in the 2017 Annual Budget of Quezon City or from any available funds.


