RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7207**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL AND THE NOVALICHES DISTRICT HOSPITAL TO JOINTLY UNDERTAKE THE FORMULATION OF A CITY BLOOD DONATION PROGRAM AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CITY GOVERNMENT BLOOD BANK IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7719, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE NATIONAL BLOOD SERVICES ACT OF 1994.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7719, also known as the National Blood Services Act of 1994, promotes voluntary blood donation to provide sufficient supply of safe blood and to regulate blood banks;

WHEREAS, the National Blood Services Act aims to inculcate public awareness that blood donation is a humanitarian act. It also provides for the establishment of a scientific and professional standards for the operation of blood collection units and blood banks/centers in the Philippines;



WHEREAS, the formulation of a City Blood Donation Program and the establishment of a City Government Blood Bank seeks to provide a local mechanism by which Republic Act No. 7719, otherwise known as the "National Blood Services Act of 1994", shall be realized in Quezon City for the benefit of the residents who are in need of blood transfusion.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Quezon City Health Department, the Quezon City General Hospital and the Novaliches District Hospital to jointly undertake the formulation of a City Blood Donation Program and the establishment of a City Government Blood Bank, in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 7719, otherwise known as the "National Blood Services Act of 1994".


