CARPIO AND BY ITS GROUP DIRECTOR FOR EAST ZONE BUSINESS OPERATIONS, FERDINAND M. DELA CRUZ FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING EMERGENCY RESERVOIR WITHIN THE POTENTIAL SITES IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, in order to immediately respond to the necessities of evacuees in an event of a disaster, the LGU has the power and authority to partner with the private sector to ensure the planning and construction of Emergency Reservoirs for use the member there is an emergency or disaster or a state calamity declared either by the local legislative bodies or the Office of the President;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Quezon (the "LGU-QC"), cognizant with the efficient and egyptime governance of the private sector, shall coordinate with Manila water Co., Inc., in order to provide calibrated relief action during communes and disasters;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Concession Agreement executed by Manila Water Co., Inc., and interropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System (MWSS) for the construction of Emergency Reservoirs to provide water supply to evacuees thereas an times of natural calamities, the

WHEREAS, pursuant to the conditions of the Easement of Right-of-Way, Manila Water Co., Inc., and the EGU-QC shall comply with the conditions provided in the foregoing:

WHEREAS, the Easement of Right of Way shall become effective from the date of the execution increas and shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act. No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in an its vusiness transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of Sanggardang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED. To authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorapic Herbert M. Bautista, to grant the gratuitous—easement of right-of way by Manila Water Co., Inc., represented by its Group Director for Project Delivery, Geodino V. Carpio and by its Group Director for East Zone Business Operations, Ferdinand M. Dela Cruz for the purpose of constructing emergency reservoir within the potential sites in Quezon City.
