RESOLUTION NO. 279, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO GRANT THE GRATUITOUS EASEMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY BY MANILA WATER CO., INC., REPRESENTED BY ITS GROUP DIRECTOR FOR PROJECT DELIVERY, GEODINO V. CARPIO AND BY ITS GROUP DIRECTOR FOR EAST ZONE BUSINESS OPERATIONS, FERDINAND M. DELA CRUZ FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING EMERGENCY RESERVOIR WITHIN THE POTENTIAL SITES IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, in order to immediately respond to the necessities of evacuees in an event of a disaster, the LGU has the power and authority to partner with the private sector to ensure the planning and construction of Emergency Reservoirs for use whenever there is an emergency or disaster or a state calamity declared either by the local legislative bodies or the Office of the President;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Quezon (the "LGU-QC"), cognizant with the efficient and effective governance of the private sector, shall coordinate with Manila Water Co., Inc., in order to provide calibrated relief action during calamities and disasters;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Concession Agreement executed by Manila Water Co., Inc., and Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System (MWSS) for the construction of Emergency Reservoirs to provide water supply to evacuees therein in times of natural calamities, the

Manila water Co., Inc., has an sole right to manage, operate and maintain all fixed and moveable assets required to provide water delivery and sewerage services in the East Service Area of the franchise;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the conditions of the Easement of Right-of-Way, Manila Water Co., Inc., and the LGU-QC shall comply with the conditions provided in the foregoing;

WHEREAS, the Easement of Right of Way shall become effective from the date of the execution thereof and shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 155 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to grant the gratuitous easement of right-of-way by Manila Water Co., Inc., represented by its Group Director for Project Delivery, Geodino V. Carpio and by its Group Director for East Zone Business Operations, Ferdinand M. Dela Cruz for the purpose of constructing emergency reservoir within the potential sites in Quezon City.
