RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7316**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PROCURE EIGHT (8) UNITS OF MOTORIZED VEHICLE, TO BE UTILIZED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG), FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION, OPERATION AND MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THE CITY, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that, "The City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

WHEREAS, Section 455 (4) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the City Mayor shall "Ensure the delivery of basic services and the provision of adequate facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this Code and, in addition thereto, shall:

(i) Ensure that the construction and repair of roads and highways funded by the national government shall be, as far as practicable, carried out in a spatially contiguous manner and in coordination with the construction and repair of the roads and bridges of the city, x.x.x; and

(ii) Coordinate the implementation of technical services, including public works and infrastructure program, rendered by national offices in the case of highly urbanized and independent component cities, and by national and provincial offices in the case of component cities;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C, 2013, "requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursements charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made" citing the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisimbing vs Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (GR No. 175527) decided by the Supreme Court as basis;

WHEREAS, a request was made by the different Departments and Offices of the Quezon City Government, to procure Eight (8) units of motor vehicle to be utilized for transport of personnel on site inspections, surveys, research works, meetings, seminars, delivery of communications, materials and other official activities that are necessary for the implementation, operation and monitoring of their respective programs and/or projects;

WHEREAS, the motor vehicles requested shall have the following specifications, to wit:
