A RESOLUTION URGING ALL ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY TO DISPLAY THE CURRENT YEAR SANITARY PERMIT AND HEALTH CERTIFICATES FOR PUBLIC VIEW.

WHEREAS, based on Presidential Decree No. 856 (otherwise known as "The Code on Sanitation of the Philippines"), Ordinance No. SP-2503, S-2016, an amendment of SP-1735, S-2006 (otherwise known as "The Sanitation Code of Quezon City") and Article 30 Section 131 of the Quezon City Revenue Code, as Amended states: "every owner/operator of business establishments shall secure annually a Sanitary Permit for the purpose of supervision and enforcement of existing rules and regulations on sanitation and safety of the public. "Every Sanitary Permit shall be posted in a conspicuous place of the establishment; y

WHEREAS, an establishment has to comply with the prescribed requirements before a Sanitary Permit and Health Certificate be issued. The requirements vary depending on the nature of the business of a given establishment;

WHEREAS, no person shall be employed or involved in the operation of any Quezon City Based Establishment without a Health Certificate issued by the City Health Office Authority. This shall be renewed annually;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Health Department - Sanitation Division estimates that only 30% - 35% of all registered businesses operating in Quezon City have applied for a Sanitary Permit. Only approximately 80% of which were able to successfully secure a Sanitary Permit;

WHEREAS, the Health Certificate of employees working in an establishment shall be clipped visibly in the upper left front portion of the uniform while working or if not feasible, shall be made available at all times when asked by the health authority or general public;

WHEREAS, the failure of an establishment to display for public view its current year Sanitary Permit and non-wearing of Health Certificates of personnel will be subjected to a penalty as prescribed in City Ordinance No. SP 2503, S-2016;

WHEREAS, the general public shall be offered and provided with quality products and services. This has to conform to sanitation standards as required by P.D. Nos. 856, 522 and Ordinance No. SP-2503, S-2016;

WHEREAS, one of the bases of the general public that Sanitation Standards are met is the issuance of an annual Sanitary Permit to an establishment and health certificates to all personnel.
