WHEREAS, last August 21 and 22, 2017, the Philippine Fencing Team won six (6) medals in the said prestigious Game;

WHEREAS, two-time UAAP Juniors Most Valuable Player Samantha Kyle Catantan won silver medal in the women's individual foil that took place at MATRADE Exhibition and Convention Centre in Segambut. Her teammate Maxene Esteban pocketed the bronze in the same event.

WHEREAS, Louie Wayne Brennan took the men's individual foil gold medal over compatriot Nathaniel Perez who got silver in a dominant show for the Philippines.

WHEREAS, the Philippine women's epee team also had an impressive showing, turning in a silver and a bronze. Hanniel Abella got the silver while her teammate Harlene Raguin took the bronze.

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the City Government to recognize and commend the hard work and determination of the fencing athletes who represented the Philippines in the 2017 Southeast Asian Games and who brought honor and pride to our country.
