RESOLUTION NO. SP- 7386 , S-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP5,000.00) TO EACH OF THE TWO HUNDRED FORTY FOUR (244) INFORMAL SETTLER FAMILIES (ISFs) WHO WILL BE AFFECTED BY ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN BARANGAYS STO. DOMINGO AND MANRESA, QUEZON CITY, SPECIFICALLY STO. DOMINGO, PAGATAAN AND PANALTURAN STREETS, EQUIVALENT TO A TOTAL AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP1,220,000.00).

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government (LGU-QC), in partnership with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), has implemented road improvement projects at Sto. Domingo Street, Pagatan Street and Panaltural Street, in Barangay Sto. Domingo and Barangay Manresa, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, based on census survey conducted by the Housing, Community Development and Resettlement Department (HCDRD), Two Hundred Forty Four (244) informal settler families (ISFs) were verified occupying the right-of-ways of the aforementioned streets and the same will be affected by the said road improvement projects;

WHEREAS, in an effort to relocate the ISFs to permanent and safer ground and finally clear the subject areas so as to fully implement said projects, the Quezon City Government has negotiated the relocation of all the affected ISFs to National Housing Authority (NHA) resettlement site in Morong, Rizal;

WHEREAS, to draw cooperation from the affected ISFs and also to provide them with something to start with the resettlement site, there is a need for the Quezon City Government to allocate and extend financial assistance fund to the Two Hundred Forty Four (244) affected ISFs in the total amount of One Million Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Pesos (Php1,220,000.00) or an equivalent amount of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) per ISF;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend financial assistance of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) to each of the Two Hundred Forty Four (244) informal settler families (ISFs) to be

affected by the road improvement projects in Barangays Sto. Domingo and Manresa, specifically Sto. Domingo Street, Pagataan Street and Panalturan Street, who are about to be relocated to National Housing Authority (NHA) Resettlement Site in Morong, Rizal, equivalent to a total amount of One Million Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Pesos (Php1,220,000.00).
