WHEREAS, on July 14, 2018, City Prosecutor Donald T. Lee of Quezon City will retire from the government service upon reaching the compulsory retirement age of sixty five (65) years having been born on July 14, 1953; *γ* *δ* *ε*

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government has still several matters of vital importance to the employees of said office to be discussed and threshed out with him as head of office one of which is the funding of the salaries and other benefits of said employees which should be shouldered by the National Government and not by the City;




WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government likewise has several cases involving the city ordinances that are penal in nature as well as other special laws involving illegal construction of buildings and occupancy permits and the like under investigation/prosecution of prosecutors who are under the control and supervision of the said City Prosecutor;

WHEREAS, in order to forestall delays on the matters involving said employees and other similar matters that are presently being taken up with several meetings conducted and paper works involved, it will be expedient and judicious for the City Prosecutor to thresh it out having a firsthand knowledge as to the intricacies surrounding the same;

WHEREAS, anent the cases filed by the Quezon City Government through the authorized officials, the City Prosecutor has likewise clearly have a working knowledge as to the proceedings being conducted and it will be for the best interest of the City that he maintains control and supervision over the proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request President Rodrigo Roa Duterte, Republic of the Philippines, through Secretary Vitaliano N. Aguirre II, Department of Justice, Manila, to extend the service of City Prosecutor Donald T. Lee, Office of the City Prosecutor, Quezon City, in the best of public interests. ✕




