A RESOLUTION STRONGLY SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL NO. 398 ENTITLED "AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY TANDANG SORA, QUEZON CITY TO BE KNOWN AS TANDANG SORA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR".

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "The State shall protect and promote the right of all the citizens to quality education at all levels, and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all";

WHEREAS, Section 17, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution further underscores that "The state shall give priority to education. . . to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development";

WHEREAS, consistent with the thrust of the National Government, the Local Government of Quezon City recognizes the importance, and gives priority to public education, specifically public elementary, junior high schools and senior high schools, for the development of the City;

WHEREAS, there is no existing senior high school in Barangay Tandang Sora to cater to the junior high school students of Tandang Sora High School;

WHEREAS, upon graduation, these students face geographic, logistical and economic difficulties in continuing with senior high school education;

WHEREAS, with the enactment of Republic Act No. 10533, otherwise known as the "Enhanced Basic Education Act 2013", it is imperative that additional schools be established;


