A RESOLUTION STRONGLY SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL NO. 7060 ENTITLED "AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY TALIPAPA, QUEZON CITY TO BE KNOWN AS TALIPAPA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR".

WHEREAS, Sections 1 and 2, Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates the State to "protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education" and to "establish and maintain a system of free public education in the elementary and high school levels";

WHEREAS, the Local Government of Quezon City recognizes the importance of education in the development and progress of a community, as such, the city provides sufficient funds for education and encourages Quezon City students to be diligent and persevering in their studies to become productive residents of the city;

WHEREAS, there is no existing senior high school in Barangay Talipapa to cater to its students;

WHEREAS, with the enactment of Republic Act No. 10533, otherwise known as the "Enhanced Basic Education Act 2013," it is imperative that additional schools be established;


WHEREAS, the Local Government of Quezon City deems it necessary to create more public senior high schools in the City, including Barangay Talipapa, to be able to fulfill its constitutional mandate of providing access to basic education for the people.

NOW, THEREFORE


