RESOLUTION NO. SP-\_ 7438 , S-2018

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF PAYLINE INCORPORATED TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC BINGO OR E-BINGO AT THE GROUND FLOOR OF Z SQUARE MALL, DEL MONTE AVENUE CORNER BANAWE AVENUE, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

Introduced by Councilor IVY XENIA L. LAGMAN.

WHEREAS, Payline Incorporated, a domestic corporation, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, represented by its President, Mr. Justin Gotianse, with principal office address at AG003 Ground Floor, Francis Street, Julia Vargas, Mandaluyong City, is applying for the Renewal of its Special Permit to operate an Electronic Bingo or E-Bingo;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council previously passed a Resolution granting a Special Permit to the applicant to operate the said Electronic Bingo;

WHEREAS, to enable Payline Incorporated to continue its legal business operation, there is a need to renew their Special Permit;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, in relation to existing city ordinances, authorizes the City Council to grant special permit to business activity of the same nature.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Payline Incorporated to operate an Electronic Bingo or E-Bingo at the Ground Floor of Z Square Mall, Del Monte Avenue corner Banawe Avenue, Quezon City, subject to the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the authority to operate Electronic Bingo or E-Bingo granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. The holding of Electronic Bingo or E-Bingo shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
- b. The operation of Electronic Bingo or E-Bingo shall not include the playing of games not related to or other than bingo;
- c. The operator is enjoined to prohibit individuals below eighteen (18) years of age from playing in the abovementioned games.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that Payline, Incorporated shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasury Office during the lifetime of this measure.
