RESOLUTION NO. SP- 7447, S-2018

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA TO INSTALL LED (LIGHT EMITTING DIODE) ROAD MONITORING ADVISORY SYSTEM IN ALL MAJOR THOROUGHFARES IN QUEZON CITY TO PROVIDE MOTORISTS OF REAL TIME TRAFFIC INFORMATION AND SITUATIONS.

WHEREAS, traffic is undeniably a long standing problem in Metro Manila. Different factors such as volume of cars, inefficient traffic policies, road constructions and repairs, and undisciplined drivers thereof, contribute to and aggravate traffic situations in major thoroughfares in the metropolis and Quezon City is not spared from this, and makes everyday experience of motorists and commuters alike intolerable and hard;

\* WHEREAS, over 20,000 in Quezon City alone use a car to commute, and 65 percent of them drive by themselves;

WHEREAS, there are measures that make transport system safe and smooth flowing through a set of advanced traffic systems called Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS). It was installed in the North and South Expressway called Expressway Monitoring Advisory System (EMAS) which is connected to a highly sophisticated and integrated backend;

WHEREAS, the traffic update is aggregated, integrated and disseminated at the ITS center for traffic monitoring and management. Real time and localized traffic information is disseminated through a LED billboard installed a distance away from a perennial traffic gridlock;


WHEREAS, information such as congested routes, traffic accident ahead and location of road works and repair will help motorists to decide to change directions or use alternative routes to reach their destination faster;

WHEREAS, to alleviate the Quezon City residents' pain of worsening traffic conditions, an alternative system such as a road monitoring advisory system may help in decongesting traffic within its territorial jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista to install LED (Light Emitting Diode) Road Monitoring Advisory System in all major thoroughfares in Quezon City to provide motorists of real time traffic information and situations.


