RESOLUTION NO. SP. 7448 , S-2018

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND PROMOTION OFFICE (FORMERLY SIKAP BUHAY ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND COOPERATIVES OFFICE) TO CONDUCT LIVELIHOOD SKILLS TRAINING, BUSINESS AND ENTREPRENEURIAL SKILLS SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS AND PROVIDE A MICROFINANCE SCHEME IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00) PER FAMILY TO THE DISPLACED PAYATAS SANITARY LANDFILL WORKERS, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. SP-1607, S-2005 provides for the objectives of Small Business Development and Promotion Office (formerly known as Sikap Buhay Entrepreneurship and Cooperative Office) which includes but is not limited to, providing entrepreneurship training and education, promoting self-reliance among the underprivileged constituents of Quezon City and facilitating the provision of start-up capital for small scale entrepreneurs;

WHEREAS, the Environmental Management Bureau-National Capital Region (EMB-NCR), a bureau of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR,) ordered the abrupt closure of the Payatas Sanitary Landfill;

WHEREAS, the abrupt closure left thousand of Barangay Payatas residents with no means of livelihood and there is a need to address the loss of livelihood of said constituents;

WHEREAS, the Environment Protection and Wastes Management Department (EPWMD) defined Payatas Landfill workers as individuals registered as a worker under Payatas Alliance Recycling Exchange Multi-purpose Cooperative with a valid identification card proving such membership;

WHEREAS, the City Government is responsible for the promotion of the social welfare of its citizens particularly the marginalized informal workers sector.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request the Small Business Development and Promotion Office (Formerly Sikap Buhay Entrepreneurship and Cooperatives Office) to conduct Livelihood Skills Training, Business and Entrepreneurial Skills Seminars and Workshops and provide a microfinance scheme in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) per family to the displaced Payatas Sanitary Landfill Workers, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.
