A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CONTRACTS OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG) THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, WITH THE WINNING BIDDERS AND/OR CONTRACTORS OF THE VARIOUS INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, General Rule in Procurement or Disposal. - Except as otherwise provided herein, acquisition of supplies and services by local government units shall be through competitive public bidding. x.x.x ;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of the same Code, "the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

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WHEREAS, to improve the delivery of basic and public services, as well as the living standards and conditions of its residents, the Quezon City Government through Mayor Herbert M. Bautista entered into Contracts of Agreement with the winning bidders and/or contractors of various infrastructure projects, specifically described as follows, to wit:


